TRANSPORT

COMING TO VALENCIA

AIRPORT

The airport is 8 kilometres from the city centre. There are several options for travelling to the city centre. By metro, there is Line 3 (Aeropuerto / Palmaret- Rafelbunyol) and Line 5 (Aeropuerto/Torrent Avinguda- Neptú). By bus, line 150 (Valencia - Manises - Airport) is available. Access by road is via the V-11 motorway, which connects the A-3 (Madrid-Valencia motorway) with the V-30. There are also taxis at the airport exit.

TRAIN

The city has two main railway stations within its municipal boundaries. The high-speed (AVE) station is called Joaquín Sorolla. It has free buses, which with your train ticket will take you to the Estación del Norte, located in the city centre.

Joaquín Sorolla Station is served by metro lines 1 and 5 (Joaquín Sorolla stop) and bus lines 9, 10, 27 (San Vicente Mártir stop) and lines 89 and 90 (Av. Giorgeta stop).

Metro lines 3 and 5 (with a stop at Xàtiva) reach the North Station. There are several bus options, the lines are 5, 6, 7, 8, 8, 10, 10, 11, 14, 19, 19, 35, 40 and 63 (stops near the Town Hall Square).

ROAD

Valencia is equipped with a modern road network, which makes it easily accessible from any city, both on the peninsula and beyond. The AP-7 Mediterranean motorway, which runs from north to south along the entire

Levantine coast, connects with the European motorway network and with the A-23 Sagunto-Somport and A-3 Madrid-Valencia motorways.

Most of the passenger transport services operating in Valencia, both national and international, start and end at the Valencia Menéndez Pidal Bus Station, at Avenida Menéndez Pidal, 13. It is accessible by metro from lines 1 and 2 (Túria) and from bus lines 8, 29, 60, 61,62, 63, 73, 79 (generally stopping at Nuevo Centro).

MOVING AROUND VALENCIA

METRO & TRAM

The metro is the fastest way to commute around Valencia. A single ticket costs 1.50€, while a ten-trip pass costs 9.00€. There are parts of Valencia that cannot be reached by metro. For these occasions, there is usually a tram that takes its place and runs on the same tickets.
